Voter Integrity Summit

The [True the Vote National Summit](#) this weekend will be streamed live, since it is sold out with liberty-organization leaders attending from over twenty-five states. This will allow all of us to become informed about this most important issue threatening the integrity of our election system. Live streaming will begin at 7:30 p.m. EST on Friday, March 25th. The [King Street Patriots](#), who are sponsoring this national summit, have done much in uncovering voter fraud in Houston and will share key learnings during this summit. The summit will also feature many of the voter fraud experts from throughout the country. Some of the main speakers will be: [Anita MonCrief](#) (formerly of ACORN), [John Fund](#) (Author of : *Stealing Elections: How Voter Fraud Threatens Our Democracy*) , [Hans Von Spakovsky](#) (Senior Legal Fellow at The Heritage Foundation's Center for Legal and Judicial Studies), [Senator Norm Coleman](#), [Warner Todd Huston](#), [Andrew Breitbart](#), and [Christian Adams](#).

Clearly, in addition to pursuing "*Neighborhood / Precinct Organizing*" to engage and mobilize like-minded, concerned conservative and moderate voters, who have decided to be the "Silent Majority" no more, we must be vigilant to stop voter fraud which disenfranchises legitimate votes. Analyses have shown that much of the voter fraud is facilitated by voter access initiatives advocated by liberals, such as automatic voter registration when applying for driver licenses, unrestricted absentee ballots, and early voting.

In 2010, liberals were discussing a *Universal Voter Registration* (UVR) law, which would have further subverted and corrupted the voter registration process. The *Universal Voter Registration* (UVR) law would have overridden all state election laws and forced states to register everyone to vote who is on welfare, is unemployed, has a driver's license, or is a property owner. Many people on these lists are duplicates and many are illegal aliens. Project. Voting fraud or voting irregularities were made possible by actions and decisions made by these Secretaries of States. For example, in Ohio, where President Obama beat Senator McCain by fewer than 270,000 votes, [read on our website](#) how 600,000 new Ohio voters were registered, with many having discrepancies since they failed the "match-up" test in which voter information is compared to driver's license and Social Security databases. Ohio's Secretary of State refused to address this issue.

Recruiting and Managing Volunteers

For local liberty-minded organizations to effectively and efficiently implement the many aspects of [Neighborhood/Precinct Organizing](#) they will have to adopt many of the best management business practices and transpose them to a volunteer effort. This is necessary for organizations to successfully recruit, inspire, and retain volunteers in order to expand an organization's effectiveness and reach. Specifically, these management practices include: volunteer recruiting, how to be an effective servant-leader, breaking "complicated" tasks into simpler tasks, and allowing capable volunteers to rapidly assume responsibility and ownership.

Cheryl Strabala of Nevada, who worked on the Sharron Angle campaign in 2010, has done an excellent job documenting her successful and proven leadership practices into a manual titled ["Invite and Invest"](#). She has given us permission to share this detailed manual, accessible by just clicking on the highlighted title. Cheryl doubled the number of phone-bank volunteers and increased daily phone-bank calls by over 400% within just the first two weeks.
